### Air Travel

#### Sacramento International Airport

Located just 10-minutes from Downtown, the Sacramento International Airport (SMF) is connected by 11 airlines with 19 nonstop flights across the county, and services all major California cities. The Terminal B expansion will be completed in October 2011.
