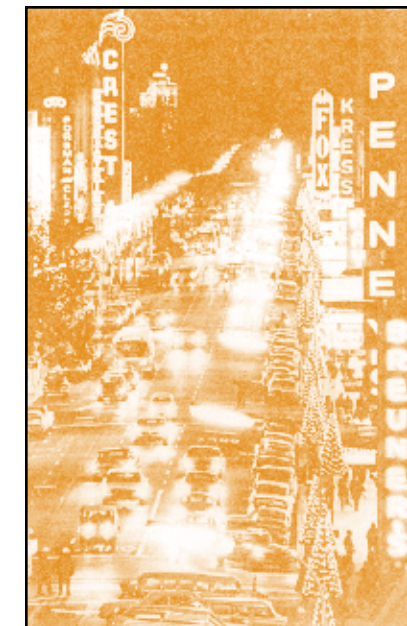

Find Your Way Downtown

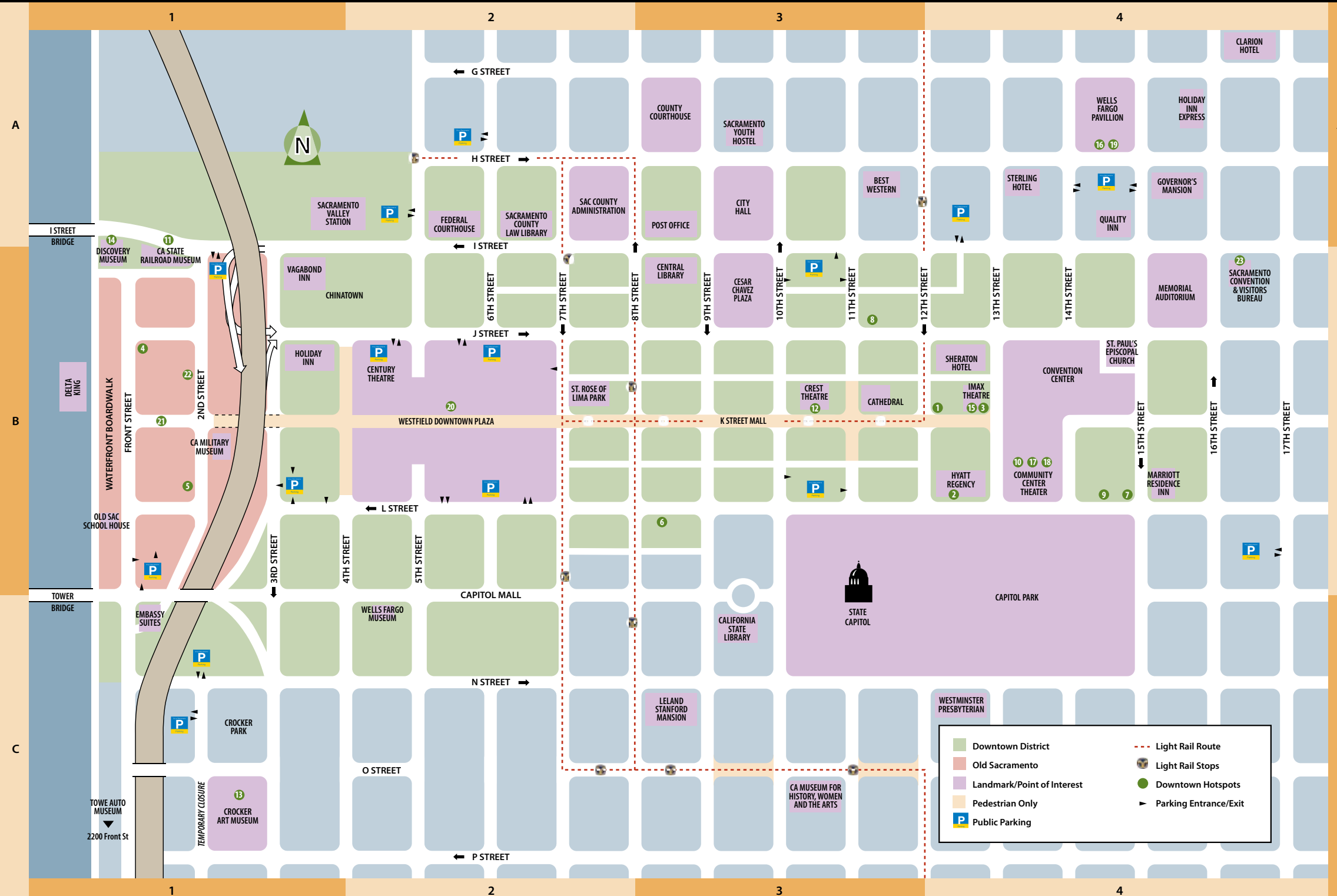
Downtown Sacramento is laid out in a simple alpha-numeric grid format. Streets that run East to West are in alphabetical order, while streets that run North to South are numerical. For example, 900 J Street is located at 9th & J streets.

Addresses on the numbered blocks are easy to find as well. The lettered streets correspond to a number. "I" is the 9th letter in the alphabet, while "J" is the 10th. A business located at 915 9th Street is located between I Street and J Street.

There are two exceptions to this system: Front Street in Old Sacramento could be considered 1st Street and M Street has been renamed Capitol Mall.
