










Why Mailchimp?

Promotes business to consumer relationships.




Getting Started

Content Studio (Organize content)


Grow Your Mailchimp Audience

Your audience is where you'll store and manage your contacts. Once you add your contacts, you'll be able to send your first campaign. We'll walk you through the process.





Add your consumers/subscribers.


You can import subscribers using CRM (customer relationship management) tools, through an Excel or TXT file or copy and paste contacts directly onto Mailchimp.

To manually add contacts, click "All contacts," go to the "Add contacts" and select "Add a subscriber."

Add Contacts



You must have the person's email address to add them as a subscriber. Their full name, address and title are optional.

At the end of the list, you must answer if the person gave you permission to add them to your lists.

Create Tags

Tag your contacts

Easily organize your contacts using simple words or phrases that make the most sense to you.

Use tags to categorize your contacts.

For example, create a "Specials" tag for subscribers interested in menu specials. Or if you own an event menu, create a tag for subscribers interested in "entertainment."

Build, design, and translate signup forms and response emails

Embedded forms

Generate HTML code to embed in your site or blog to collect signups.

Subscriber pop-up

Design a pop-up signup form that can be embedded on any site.

Contact Form

Let your customers reach you directly with a contact form that sends messages to your <u>Inbox</u>.

Form integrations

Create signup forms using one of our integrations.

Mailchimp gives you multiple form options to use for your newsletters and websites.

Form Builder - Create signup forms and response emails.

<u>Embedded Forms</u> - Embed HTML codes onto your website.

<u>Subscriber Pop Up</u> - Create a pop up signup form to embed on your site.

<u>Contact Form</u> - Build a form subscribers can fill out to reach you.

<u>Form Integrations</u> - Create forms using an integration.

Use <u>Form Builder</u> to create a signup form.

Insert sections like text, radio buttons, check boxes, birthday, address and any other information you want to ask.







Creating an Email Template




With each design you'll be able to add text blocks, images or clickable buttons that link to websites, emails or documents.

Analytics & Reports

Email Analytics summarizes metrics across multiple emails so you can easily see how they're performing, identify data trends and more. Upgrade to our Standard plan to get Email Analytics and the insight you need to improve your marketing.

Choose your 4 most important metrics and see how they've performed for the last week, month, quarter or year.




Identify trends

Automations




Automations are used as a chain reaction.

When someone signs up for your newsletter or complete an order, you can make it trigger a response email.


In order to use "journeys" (aka automations), you must upgrade your account.

Content Studio



Mailchimp offers a "content studio" to organize your images, logos, designs and documents.

Integrations



Mailchimp allows you to link other platforms to its system.

You'll be able to update your mailing list more efficiently and connect with your customers on one platform.

Sending Emails



Figure out what your audience likes.

Create a survey and identify categories you believe will interest your subscribers.

Ask them to give written feedback on types of content they want to receive from your business.

Once you have this figured out, create tags to assign your contacts and begin creating email templates for each topic.

Tracking Emails



After successfully sending out emails, monitor the open and click rate for each campaign (template) you send out.

This will give you an idea what your audience is attracted to.

Also keep track of how many people unsubscribe from your emails. This can give you a heads up if a particular topic is performing well or if subscribers are receiving too many emails from your business.
