Two-hour metered street parking is available throughout the Old Sacramento Waterfront Sunday – Saturday from 10 a.m.–10 p.m. (After 10 p.m., street parking is free) If your event is during the holidays, you can take advantage of free holiday parking on select days and times.

Three public parking garages are available:

- Tower Bridge Garage, entrance on Capitol Mall & Front Street.
